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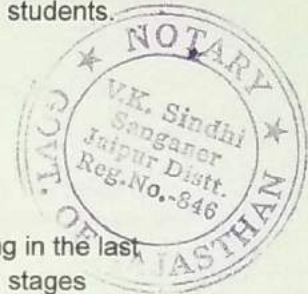

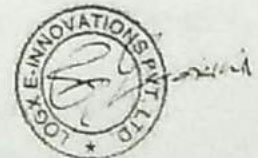

Responsibilities of College:

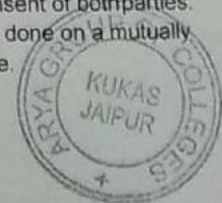
- Recognize Internshala as the internship and training partner in all internal and external communications including on its website and in admission/media brochures.
- Send a communication to all the students and faculties regarding the association and direct/encourage students to verify their accounts.
- Provide the information of all the interested students of the College as required by Internshala for their registration. The information should contain the first name, last name, mobile number and the email address of all the students of the College.
- Regularly post a list of students selected for internships through Internshala every month on the college's notice board.
- Authorize Internshala to recognize college, using College logo and/or brand name, as a registered user in its communications (internal or external) and on Internshala platform only for the purpose limited to the scope of the agreement.

Commercials:

This is a non-commercial agreement whereas neither party is required to make any payment to other party for carrying out the responsibilities listed in this agreement.

Term and Termination:

This agreement will be operational and valid from <date> and the initial tenure of the agreement is 1 (one) year. Upon completion of the tenure, the agreement can be renewed for another 1 year and so on with mutual consent of both parties. Under normal circumstances, either party wanting to terminate the agreement can do so and it can be done on a mutually agreed upon date in a justified way with a notification given at least one month prior to termination date.



- Welcome AIET, Jaipur to use CADD Centre strategically based on the need.

AIET, Jaipur Shall Provide:

- The required number of computer systems required configuration, switch in the lab and other required infrastructure for the practice
- The Class rooms with LCD projector for the theory classes.
- Schedule the classes for the training.
- The supports to ensure, all students attend the training program.
- The relevant software installed in the computer systems.
- Disciplinary supports for the smooth and timely completion of the entire course.
- Shall provide minimum hours for complete the training program.

PARTICIPANTS:

The participants would be the Students of AIET, Jaipur from specified branches from Mechanical/Civil from the 2nd year to 4th year.

COURSE CONTENTS:

CADD Centre in consultation with AIET, Jaipur shall finalize the courses and fees for the skills development program. The same is providing in the Annexure – 1 & 2. These will be reviewed after 3 years and suitable changes, if required, will be incorporated. As the requirement of course is different, courses and fees have been worked out separately for each branch.



COMMENCEMENT OF COURSE

AIET, Jaipur will ensure that the courses will start within 15 (Fifteen) days from the date of signing of MOU. CADD Centre will ensure that course will commence from November 2019 on intimation from AIET, Jaipur. However, exception can be made due to reasons mentioned in the Course Completion Clause or due to delay on AIET, Jaipur's side.

COURSE FEES & PAYMENT PATTERN

The course fee per student for each course offered is decided and mutually agreed by both the parties. The course fee and the payment pattern are available in the Annexure – 1 & 2. The student shall pay the course fee directly to AIET, Jaipur.

AIET, Jaipur will make payment by Cheque or DD in favor of BHARGAVA ASSOCIATES (Authorized Franchise Raja Park centre).

Student's Benefit

1. Minor project will be completed by students after completion of course and full time support provided by CADD CENTRE RAJA PARK JAIPUR.
2. For Major project, CADD CENTRE RAJA PARK JAIPUR will provide the full time support for students.
3. Student's also may take back support from CADD CENTRE Raja Park Jaipur at their site for not only course related even for Project work too, it may be minor or major.
4. CADD CENTRE RAJA PARK JAIPUR will provide the back support up to 3 year's for major / minor project's to student's.
5. All students' will get Authorized course material of CADD CENTRE and globally certified Certificate. Authorized from all parental company of software like, Autodesk, PTC, Bentley, Dassault System, Ansys etc.

JURISDICTION

All matters, queries, disputes, or differences, whatsoever, arising between the parties touching the construction, meaning, operation or effect of this Memorandum of Understanding or out of or relating to this Memorandum of Understanding or breach thereof shall be settled through arbitration in accordance with the relevant Arbitration Act in force at such time. The Arbitration award shall be binding on both parties.




VALIDITY
