Sub: Extension of approval / increase / variation in intake / introduction of additional courses to the ARYA INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING & TECH. SP-40A, RICO INDUSTRIAL AREA, KUKAS, JAIPUR, RAJASTHAN-303101 for the academic year 2007-08.

As per the Regulations notified by the Council vide F.No. 37.3/Legal/2004 dated 14th September 2006 and norms, standards, procedures and conditions prescribed by the Council from time to time and based on the recommendations of Appraisal Committee / Expert Committee, I am directed to convey the extension of approval of the Council to ARYA INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING & TECH. SP-40A, RICO INDUSTRIAL AREA, KUKAS, JAIPUR, RAJASTHAN-303101 for conduct of the following courses with the intake indicated below:

The additional intake is being granted based on the projections shown in the Detailed project Report regarding additional built-up space, faculty and other facilities for the proposed intake. It may be noted that all facilities including additional built-up area and of faculty should be made available before the commencement of the academic year. The norms and standards of AICTE regarding period of approval would be applicable by Council.

The above approval is subject to rectification of the following observations / deficiencies / specific conditions by 31st August 2007.

Faculty

1. Sr. level faculty in cadre ratio as per AICTE norms should be appointed.
2. AICTE P57 scales should be implemented for all the faculty and staff.
3. Faculty in the Humanities & Sc. should be appointed in the ratio of 1:15 for the incoming batch of students.

Others :

1. Placement cell needs improvement.
2. The deficiencies communicated in the last approval letter are not fully complied with.

Note: The specific deficiencies for not granting increase / variation in intake / additional courses to the institution are mentioned below:

1. The Total Intake cannot exceed 420.
2. Sr. level faculty to be appointed as per AICTE norms & Standards.

You may avail the opportunity of reconsideration of your proposal after rectification of the above mentioned deficiencies along with the requisite fee & relevant documents as per the provisions in the Approval Process Handbook, 2006.

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Note: The mandatory disclosure in prescribed format is required to be hosted on the website as per AICTE requirements, failing which action would be initiated as per the rules and regulations of the AICTE including No Admission/Withdrawal of approval.

The institution is required to submit two copies of the Compliance Report indicating the rectification of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosure and details of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Website www.aicte.gov.in) to the concerned Regional Office latest by 31st August 2007 for consideration of approval beyond the session 2007-2008.

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 40,000/- in the form of demand draft in the favour of Member Secretary, AICTE, payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be entertained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiencies through surprise random inspection without any prior notice.

The approval if granted after rectification of deficiencies would be subject to the fulfillment of the following general conditions

1. That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
2. That
 - (a) That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and standards of the AICTE.
 - (b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
 - (c) That the conclusion of the course, the procedure for evaluation/assessment of students shall be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE.

- (d) That no excess admission shall be made for the institution over and above that approved under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the institution.
- (e) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
- (g) That the institution shall not conduct any course(s) in the field of technical education in the same premises/campus and/or in the name of the institution without prior permission/ approval of AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the institution.
- (h) The institution shall not conduct any non-technical course(s) in the same premises/campus under any circumstances. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the institution.

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- 3 That the institution shall operate only from the approved location and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.
- 4 That the tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/ guardians of students in any form.
- 5 That the accounts of the institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or any body or persons authorized by it.
- 6 That the Director/ Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- 7 (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.
- (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
- 8 That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
- 9 That a compliance report shall be submitted in the form of an annual report and any disclosure of information shall be made in the form of an annual report.
- 10 That if Technical Institution is B-1, it shall disclose the information of suppliers and contractors and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- 11 That a library shall be established with adequate number of books, journals, etc. in accordance with norms of AICTE.
- 12 That a computer center with adequate number of terminals, Printers etc. shall be established as per norms of AICTE.
- 13 AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year for verifying the status of the institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
- 14 That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of misrepresentation, violation of norms and standards, mal-practices etc.
- 15 That the institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant from the Central or State Government.
- 16 That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time.
